- Eurordis has supported all key points in the Commission Communication and the Member State Recommendations
- Already taken action, in particular on the following issues
 - Orphan medicinal products
 - Specialised centres and reference networks
 - Research on rare diseases
 - Registries and databases
 - Empowerment of patient organisations...

Social services: advocacy



- → With the Rapsody project Eurordis has begun looking at the crucial issue of social services, essential for coping with disease on a daily basis.
- Already achieved
 - Specific mention of 'specialised social services: help lines, respite care services and therapeutic recreation programmes' in the Commission Communication on Rare Diseases
 - November 2008

Council Recommendation on action in the field of rare diseases Europe action.

- Gathering and pooling national expertise to support:
- (a) the sharing of best practices on diagnostic tools and medical care as well as
- education and social care in the field of rare diseases;
- Empowerment of Patient organisations:
- Promote the activities performed by patient organisations, such as awareness-raising,
- capacity-building and training, exchange of information and best practices, networking and
- outreach to very isolated patients.

A European network



- A network to improve the quality of services.
- The more advanced services sharing their expertise with the start ups.
- Reflect the very diverse range of services that exist
- Rigorous membership criteria to ensure high standards.
- 'Convergence plan', training sessions and on site visits to help with reaching criteria.

- Caller profile analysis.
 - Activity statistics for whole help line network
 - Imperative that all use the orphacode for listing diseases for this to be a success.
 - Already completed a test period with six help lines

Technical tools



- Online call recording software for any help line that would like to use it.
- The answers will be anonymised and part of a central database. They will be shared and searchable by keywords in English and in local language.
- Platform for is olated patient databases to compare lists and find matches.
- The tools can be translated into new languages on demand.
- Standardised self evaluation forms

Technical tools 2



- EU wide common 116 number for harmonised social services e.g 'Missing Children number'
 - Application currently being prepared
 - Commitment of five services in five different member states needed

- Respite care costs versus long term residential care costs

- Webpage for each service, including:
 Availability, location, Diseases catered for, Medical services, Availability, etc.,
- Exchange of best practices (learning from the nordic model)
 - The online information can serve as a roadmap for any association/ establishment that would like to set up a respite service.

Therapeutic Recreation Progs Rare Diseases Europe

- 50 existing therapeutic recreation programmes identified amongst rare disease community so far (identification and directory never done before)
- All invited to update their information on the rapsodyonline listing. Including:
 - } activities
 - diseases that can be managed
 - dualifications of staff, etc.
